Update on Actions Taken Since Last Report:

Employees have been identified to move as of August 1, 2022; unsure if the EMS employees were included, but they will be identified. The budget for these employees will move on September 1, 2022.

An RFQ or RFP will be done to determine if there is a provider who is interested in clinical collaboration. There is no money in the capital plan for building a new clinic.

The Potential Space Utilization Subcommittee was formed and will be chaired by Martha Dannenbaum. Committee members are Asim Abu Baker, Cindy Weston, Mary Ann Covey, and Patty Watson. This group will explore current space and determine if this space can fit the short-term needs and report back to the SHS Working Group.

Jeff Burton reported on the Electronic Medical Records Subcommittee findings. ECW and Point and Click are the two current systems. One single platform must be used to ensure the safety of patients. Pharmacy needs access to the medical records for dispensing medications.

The Electronic Medical Records Subcommittee will examine cost factors if an interface to connect the two systems (ECW & Point & Click) is feasible. How do we combine current electronic medical records systems so that they talk to one another, or is it more advantageous to convert to one system?

A client services triage flowchart was shared. It was noted that pharmacy should be included in primary care and not a stand-alone unit. The question remains how we get the patient to the right unit for care and how follow-up care is provided. We need to consider academic program involvement.

Next Major Issue to be Addressed:

Naming: A name must be decided for the health services entity University Health Services was favored by most of the group because the name encompasses more than just serving students in the future.

Space: Look at possible locations that could accommodate future healthcare services in one location, considering locations that are accessible to the largest number of the students. A group of committee members will tour current locations and report back to the working group.

Electronic Medical Records: Determine if it is best to convert to one electronic medical records system (ECW) or come up with an interface to connect ECW and Point and Click?
